Communciation, language and literacy

Stories are at the heart of our curriculum and we love to share a wide range with the children. Some we read many times so we become very familiar with them and some are read simply for pleasure. Many of our texts this half term are about superheroes and we start off with Supertato by Sue Hendra. We will work on developing vocabulary through these books and stories and encourage children to ask and answer questions about what they have seen and heard. The children will also begin to develop their prediction skills as we talk about what might happen next based on what has already happened in a story.

In phonics the children will recap phase 2 and then start on phase 3 which includes lots of new digraphs and trigraphs to extend their reading and spelling skills.

Mathematics

We will be looking at the composition of numbers 5-8 and learning to recognise, compare and partition them into 2 or 3 groups before recombining them in early addition skills. We will also be looking at capacity, mass, length and height so there is lots to do!

Personal, social and emotional development



We will start the term thinking about new year resolutions and personal goals. The children will be encouraged to develop a positive attitude and reslilience as they try to achieve their goals. Our superhero stories will give us opportunities to talk about helping others as well as how to work as a team.

Physical development



In our weekly PE lessons we will be learning about jumping and landing correctly as well as practising a seated static balance.

We will also continue to handle large scale construction equipment and use our outdoor play area to help develop our gross motor skills.

Our fine motor skills will be developed with regular activities to help us with pencil control and handwriting.

Please ensure your child has the correct kit in school every day. We will send all kit home at half-term to be washed unless this needs to happen earlier.

Understanding the world



Our topic of People Who Help Us will help us to think about all of the things which people in our community do to help us. These will include emergency workers like firefighters and ambulance staff plus other roles like dentists and vets.

We will also find out about Chinese New Year and some of the traditions involved plus look at seasonal changes as we explore winter weather.

Expressive arts and design

We will be exploring colours and textures with different media. We will also be continuing to learn a range of traditional rhymes and songs as well as listening to music which represents different moods and feelings.


